# Overcoming Temptation 1st Reading: Genesis 9:8-15, 2nd Reading: 1 Peter3:18-22. Gospel: Mark 1:12-15

In the liturgy of this 1st Sunday of Lent, the Scriptures guide us through the profound encounter of Jesus with temptation in the desert. The Gospel of Mark succinctly narrates how "the Spirit led Jesus into the desert, he remained there for forty days, and was tempted by Satan" (Mark 1:12-13).

Temptation, an inevitable facet of human existence, is explored in the context of our Lord's humanity. As Christians, acknowledging and accepting this struggle against temptation is integral to our growth in Christian maturity.

In the face of temptations, the example of Jesus stands firm. He, with divine authority, resisted using his power for self-gratification. When tempted by the devil to turn stones into bread, Jesus proclaimed, "One does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes forth from the mouth of God" (Matthew 4:4). His power, authority, and influence were wielded not for personal pleasure but to glorify God through obedience.

A critical contemporary temptation is to misuse the power of intellect against the commandments of God. The devil cunningly presents temptations, urging us to question divine instructions and promising that nothing adverse will occur.

Mark's Gospel highlights that during Jesus's temptation, "angels ministered to him." This serves as a reminder that in our struggles, calling for divine assistance is essential. Prayer becomes non-negotiable in the battle against sin. During the Lenten season, intensified prayer, fasting, and acts of charity are emphasized to resist temptation and strengthen spiritual resolve.

Be vigilant and stay awake! Peace be with you.
